Building strong relationships with community partners at local, state, and federal levels is a key responsibility to advance the agency’s vision and mission of providing specialty counseling and community services in the region. The Director should be adept at public speaking and advocacy, and may also assist in service provision as needed. The ideal candidate will align with the agency’s mission and values, contributing to the improvement of staff, client, and community well-being.

Moreover, the ideal candidate should have experience collaborating with various funders, such as the New York State Office of Mental Health, Office of Children and Family Services, Office of Addiction Services and Supports, Department of Health, local county

departments of social services, governmental units, community partner organizations, foundations, and grantors. The Director must be adept at effectively working with a diverse range of staff and clients, encompassing differences in race, culture, religion, economic status, sexual orientation, gender identity, and abilities.
