Available programming through Family Service Society, Inc's Prevention Education Services includes:

#### PREVENTION COUNSELING

A problem-resolution focused activity that is designed to prevent or reduce substance use, problem gambling and the negative consequences of such behavior. It is limited to individuals five (5) to twenty (20) years of age. Services include assessment, individual, family and group counseling. Participants receive services based on an individualized service plan and referral to additional community resources as appropriate.

#### **EARLY INTERVENTION**

Services are designed to reduce early levels of substance use or gambling and decrease the length of time the behaviors continue and the need to refer for treatment. Prevention staff are trained in **Teen Intervene** an evidence based program for early intervention with youth between the ages of 12 and 19. After screening and early intervention is delivered, a parent session is highly recommended when possible and increases effectiveness. The program is often delivered in school settings in three (3) to six (6) sessions as a part of the school's response to substance use on school grounds and to address behavior in violation of the school's athletic code of conduct.
